# Choosing a Subject

Although the majority of commissions depict beloved pets, you may also request a custom illustration of a wildlife animal. Reference photos are required for pet portraits but optional for the wildlife route.

## Choosing a Photo

A strong reference photo is the key to a beautiful portrait! All pet commissions require at least one photo to work from. The final illustration will be based on that image. I look for 4 main elements when selecting references:

**Lighting** — A combination of light and shadow creates a greater sense of depth and makes for a more exciting portrait!

**Pose** — I prefer three-quarter pose photos taken from your pet's height, since they tend to be more dynamic than head-on portraits.

**Essence** — You know your pet much better than I do! Submit photos that capture your animal's personality and character.

**Quality**: High definition photos are a must! Blurry photos prevent me from zooming in to see all the important little details.

## Slate

My favorite way to draw. These illustrations are hand drawn on slabs of slate using charcoal and pastels. When working on slate, the natural ridges and shape of the stone become part of the artwork itself! I recommend this style to anyone looking for a truly unique, rustic portrait.

### Pricing

4 x 4" square tile*	\$130
4 x 6" slab	\$150
6 x 8" slab	\$225
12 x 12" square panel*	\$325

Please note: these prices are for single-subject portraits. Multiple subjects can be drawn on one piece of slate at an additional cost.



### **Protecting Your Slate Artwork**

Each portrait is sprayed with a varnish in order to protect the illustration and prevent fading or smudging. That being said, the artwork is not meant to be touched and should be kept indoors.

It goes without saying that slate slabs have sharp edges (they are rocks, after all). Make sure to handle the artwork with care and use the included metal stand to display the piece.

## Black Paper

I also offer custom illustrations on black paper for those looking for a more traditional approach. All commissions are created on premium black stock using professional-grade pastels, colored pencils, and charcoal. The black surface allows for striking highlights and a beautiful sense of light.

#### **Photos and Payment**

We'll work together to find a reference photo that will yield a beautiful portrait. 50% of the total payment is required up front in order to lock in your spot. ### Shipping
